Subject: 2022 Duty Crew Report

## **Background**

Beginning on Sunday, December 30, 2018 the Duty Crew Program was initiated by District Chief Robert Lehmann and his Assistant Chiefs; Jeffrey Tooker, Gregory Forgea, and Michael Benson, Jr. The duty crew program was a pilot program and then was adopted as one of the many resources our agency provides to the residents in our fire district and to our surrounding mutual aid departments. The ultimate goal of the program was to eliminate re-dispatches during the overnight hours. The Chief Officers instilled this goal to our membership. The duty crew program has been executed successfully every year since the inception of the program. This year I am eager to report again that our agency has not been re-transmitted for any calls during the duty crew hours.

As you are aware the duty crew consists of one Chief Officer and one apparatus assigned during the hours of 2200hrs-0600hrs to handle all calls in our district every week of the year. The apparatus is usually staffed with one officer and two or three firefighters.

Every week I receive a weekly roster from the other Assistant Chiefs and I upload the information into the I am Responding scheduling program. Every night a text message reminder is automatically disseminated to the members that are on duty. The I AM Responding software has allowed this program to excel due to the program maintaining the data for each firefighter, which includes their total hours every week, and the overall schedule for the entire year. At the end of the year the data is retrieved to determine each firefighter's participation in the program. The final report is reviewed by the District Chief at the end of the year, and the information is forwarded

to the District Secretary/Treasurer for data entry.

## **LOSAP Compensation**

Each member of the duty crew will receive one attendance credit for **each** shift (Monday to Sunday) period he/she volunteers. Members will continue to accrue LOSAP points for response to calls in accordance with our District's Basic Operating Procedures (BOPs).

## **2022 Statistics**

This year the East Greenbush Fire Department was dispatched to 365 calls for service and 41 calls were handled by the members of the Duty Crew. This year 58 members participated in our duty crew program. Each member completed at least one eight hour shift during the year. Attached herein are the monthly calls for service pertaining solely to the duty crew. Also attached is the full roster of members that have participated in the program for the calendar year of 2022.
